



Report from the ISM In-Depth Bible Study: In May, two of our international students, Danny Pan and Tianzhao (Jonathan) Wu, attended the International Student Ministries, Inc. In-Depth Bible Seminar for

International Students in St. Louis. This week-long conference provides students with an overview of the Bible, a study of Lutheran doctrine, and training and growth in small group ministry. Both Danny and Tianzhao reported to have had a wonderful week, and Tianzhao wrote the following about his experience:
